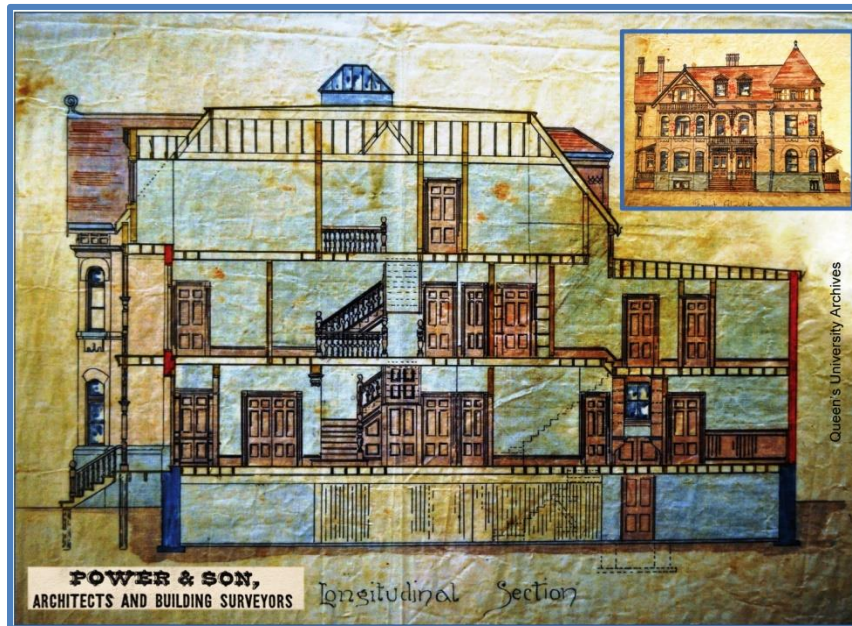


ARCHITECTS WORKING IN THE KINGSTON REGION IN THE 19TH CENTURY
